We reserve the right to remove, or to disable access to, any Contribution which does not adhere to these Rules. We expressly exclude our liability for any loss or damage arising from the use of the Interactive Features by any person in contravention of these Rules. We are under no obligation to oversee, monitor or moderate the Interactive Features provided on the website and we may stop moderating the Interactive Features at any time.
