A4ID offers a wide range of services to legal partners, enabling them to contribute meaningfully through pro bono work, training, and thought leadership.



International Pro Bono Broker Service

Weekly, ready packaged opportunities to provide pro bono legal support globally. A4ID handles due diligence and project scoping, allowing firms to focus on legal work.



Strategic Project Support

Longer term pro bono projects focused on a law firm's internal pro bono strategies, to advance an NGO's mission beyond a single matter. A4ID offers project management through the process, including document and calendar coordination.



Legal Clinics for NGOs

Online clinics for lawyers to provide pertinent legal information to NGOs in areas of law within their expertise. A4ID handles NGO registration, early submission of questions and facilitating the online forum.



Training & Professional Development

Training sessions and workshops between lawyers and NGO professionals to share knowledge on legal and development topics.
